

Ag Field Tech Job Description:

The duties of the ag field tech will include collecting, mixing, and preparing soil samples from assigned client field maps to be sent to the soil lab. The field tech must maintain organization of said samples and corresponding paperwork. This position will require the use of a company ATV and the ability to drive a soil probe into the ground for the purpose of efficiently collecting samples. The field tech must be able to use an iPhone or tablet with ease to access the necessary apps to view field maps/data.

The field tech must have the following skills to be successful: Attention to detail, time management, organizational skills, and the ability to communicate effectively with team members.

This position is seasonal and usually ends in March/April. Occasionally the duties of this job will require working in inclement weather. Hours will vary slightly but will usually be Mon. thru Fri. from 8am until 6pm due to the travel time to and from client fields in the surrounding counties. Candidate must be in good health and physical condition and be able to tolerate working outdoors.
